**Request for Reconsideration of the Denial of Recognition of Italian Citizenship by Descent –
“Minor Age Issue”**

pursuant to Italian Ministry of the Interior Circular Prot. No. 0065050 of August 10, 2026

WHEREAS

A) on [DATE THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION WAS FILED], I submitted an application to this Consulate for recognition of Italian citizenship *iure sanguinis*;

B) by denial decision Prot. No. [PROTOCOL NUMBER] dated [DATE OF DENIAL], this Consulate denied the application because the Italian parent/ancestor had naturalized while his or her child, born abroad, was still a minor, under the former interpretation commonly referred to as the “Minor Age Issue”;

C) by Circular Prot. No. 0065050 of August 10, 2026, the Italian Ministry of the Interior, following Italian Supreme Court, Joint Sections, Judgment No. 24045/2026, provided that applications previously denied on the basis of that interpretation may be reconsidered without the need to submit a new citizenship application;
therefore,

I REQUEST

that my original application for recognition of Italian citizenship *iure sanguinis* be reconsidered in light of Italian Supreme Court, Joint Sections, Judgment No. 24045/2026 and Italian Ministry of the Interior Circular Prot. No. 0065050 of August 10, 2026 and that, provided no other grounds preventing recognition exist, a new decision recognizing Italian citizenship be issued.
